Busfabriken (Childrens Play Center)

With its 2000 m², Busfabriken is one of Scandinavia's largest playgrounds for children. The children can play by themselves in the inflatable castle, jungle gyms jätte, slides, pool of balls, car racing sets and trampolines. There is also airshooting, airhockey, football / hockey and "baby corner." For adults, there is a relaxing corner with newspapers, TV and computers. There is also a cafe that serves coffee and simple dishes.

Nature

Haverdals Nature Reserve and Large Sand Hill

A staircase leads you to the top of the large Sand hill which is about 36 meters high. It is

probably Sweden's highest sand dunes and when you reach the top, you have a lovely view of the sea and the thick beach forests. Directions: Drive from Halmstad towards Steninge. After about 10 km, you drive through Gullbrandstorp. After an additional 2 km, exit on the left towards Lynga & Nature Reserve. Just follow the signs.

Prins Bertils Path

Prince Bertils path is a 13 km long coastal trail going from Halmstad's castle to Tylösand. The Tourist Office has brochures and the attractions available along the trail.

Skallen - Nature Site

Directions: From Halmstad center drive towards Steninge, exit towards Haverdal N, after about 15 k. -- turn on Särdalsvägen. Take the road to its end. Half way up, there is a parking lot available on the right side. Follow the path to reach the lookout point. *Haverdal, Halmstad*

Tolarpsfallen (Waterfalls)

Directions: From Halmstad, drive towards Kalmar - Route 25. In Skedala, turn right

towards Årnarp. Follow the signs to Tolarp and then to Marbäck.

Virsehatt - Nature Reserve

A mountain in the nature reserve. Beautiful views over Halmstad.

Kvinnohuvud (Statue)

Kvinnohuvud, the statue by Pablo Picasso is situated between the bridges along the Nissan River. The 15-meter high sculpture is made of sandblasted concrete and was placed in 1971. It is the Norwegian artist Carl Nejsar who made the sculpture according to Picasso's instructions.
